**NB:** Students in Year 3 only are levied \$65.00 per term for the Year 3 String Program, which is COMPULSORY. This cost per term covers instrument hire, tuition and insurance, strings, rosin, music folder and music other than the initial cost of Encore on Strings Music Maestro.

Students in Year 5 are offered a Band program elective at the start of the school year. The cost is \$95 per term. Once a commitment has been made to the program, the program and payments are compulsory.

Accounts for Co-Curricular Activities are sent separately by the Tutor, and are in addition to the above fees. Please refer to the Co-Curricular booklet for details on pricing.

**Sibling Reduction in Tuition Fees only; other charges are payable as stated:**

Where two or more members of the one family attend the College at the same time:  
 First child = as specified; Second child = 10%; Third child = 20%; Fourth child = 50%; Fifth and subsequent children = 100%

**Sibling Reduction in Capital Levy:**

Where three or more members of the one family attend the College at the same time:  
 First and Second child = as specified Third child = 20% Fourth and subsequent children = 50%

**NB:** Yearly payment in advance in Term 1, attracts a discount of 2.5% on the Tuition Fees only.

### **Information on Payment of Fees:**

1. School Fee statements will be emailed to your preferred billing email address. Please inform the College if you prefer a hard copy of your School Fee Account.
2. College fees are issued on a Term basis, distributed one week prior to commencement of the new Term.
3. Term fees are due in full, 5 days after the commencement of each Term.
4. Visa, Mastercard, Cash, EFPOS, Cheque and BPAY are acceptable forms of payment.
5. BPAY details are on the back page of each school fees statement.

### **Other Costs:**

Students participate in excursions, camps, swimming (and other sporting events or similar), Queensland Arts Council visits etc, at various time throughout the year. The programs are a significant factor in promoting the personal and spiritual development of the students. While the costs of these activities are borne by parents, every effort is made to keep the costs at a minimum. It will be included in your school fees account if accurate costs are known far enough in advance; otherwise they are paid for as they occur. Information detailing the cost of any activity is forwarded prior to the event for your attention.

### **Student Insurance:**

The College Student Insurance Policy provides financial benefits to students in the event of accidental injury during school activities. However, this insurance is not a medical fund. It pays for specific scenarios and limited coverage applies. Further information can be obtained from the College Nurse.

### **Visiting Teachers:**

Separate charges are made by teachers for optional private tuition for a range of activities such as Instrumental (Brass, Woodwind, Percussion, Piano, Strings, Keyboard, Guitar), Speech and Drama, Vocal (Singing), Chess, Art, Taekwondo, Dance, ESL, etc.

### **Textbook and ebook Rental:**

Text books and ebooks are issued to Years 7-12 students for a rental fee, Year 7, \$80; Year 8, \$110; Years 9 and 10, \$130; Years 11 and 12, \$170. Books that are not returned in a satisfactory condition will incur a fine or replacement cost. All Year 7 students and new students in Years 8 - 12 must also pay \$100 rental deposit before books will be issued. Rental deposits will be returned upon written application, at the time the student leaves the College, provided that all books are returned in satisfactory condition.

Please note the following school fees payment conditions applicable to the College:

### **School fees payment conditions:**

1. Payment of school fees and other costs is required to be paid, in full, by the designated date (5 days after the commencement of each term, unless otherwise stated in writing).
2. The College will charge an administration fee of \$55 (including GST). This fee is payable if school fees and other charges have not been finalised at the end of the term, or no acceptable arrangements have been entered into by that time.
3. Overdue accounts, including those where agreements for the payment have not been honoured, will result in a review of the student's continuing enrolment at the College.
4. All Year 11 students school fees account must be finalised before students are allowed to proceed into Year 12.
5. Default in payment of fees and other charges render the parents liable to legal action for recovery of the unpaid fees or other charges.
6. A full school term's notice, in writing, to the Headmaster and or Director or Enrolments, is required of intention to withdraw a student from the school, otherwise a term's tuition fee will be charged.
7. In the event that a student is asked to leave the College, all incurred fees and charges will be non refundable and any outstanding fees and charges will be immediately payable.
8. Parents who are experiencing difficulties maintaining payment of fees and charges should contact the Headmaster through the College's Commercial Manager.

***The College makes limited fee relief available to those parents experiencing financial hardship. Parents/guardians applying for some fee relief must prove they are experiencing genuine financial hardship.***
