PENNANT AWARD APPLICATION

Pennant Award Categories: Bronze Pennant: 12 points over 24 consecutive months
Silver Pennant: 14 points over 24 consecutive months
Gold Pennant: 16 points over 24 consecutive months

- Pennant points are awarded for completing activities representing the College.
- Individual lessons (eg instrumental, art, dance or speech) do not attract points, however, using these skills to represent the College in endorsed events eg Musical and competitions will attract points.
- The nominal hours refer to what contribution of the student's own time is expected by the College to complete the event.
- Students should approach teachers to have them endorse their application has having fulfilled their commitment. If you are unsure, nominal hours and points are determined by the College.
- Students can only apply for points when the activity is almost completed, thus year long activities are awarded in Term 4.
- Applications must be received before the end of the school year to earn points.
- Awarded points last for four semesters before they expire.
- Students must progress through the levels from Bronze to Silver and then Gold Awards.
- Students may see Mr Nicol or Mrs Dendy to check the database of accumulated points.
- Pennant Award badges may be worn on the day or formal uniform.

Nominal Hours guide:

1 point: Year 6 semester sport, Debating (may be 2), Amnesty, Peer Skills/Helpers, Science Club, Robotics, Nimble Fingers, SSC Public Speaking, Interact.

2 points: Years 7-12 sport per season, Performing Arts groups or ensembles, AB Public Speaking, Optiminds, Duke of Edinburgh's Award
