- Touch screen, Windows 10 device with an active digital pen

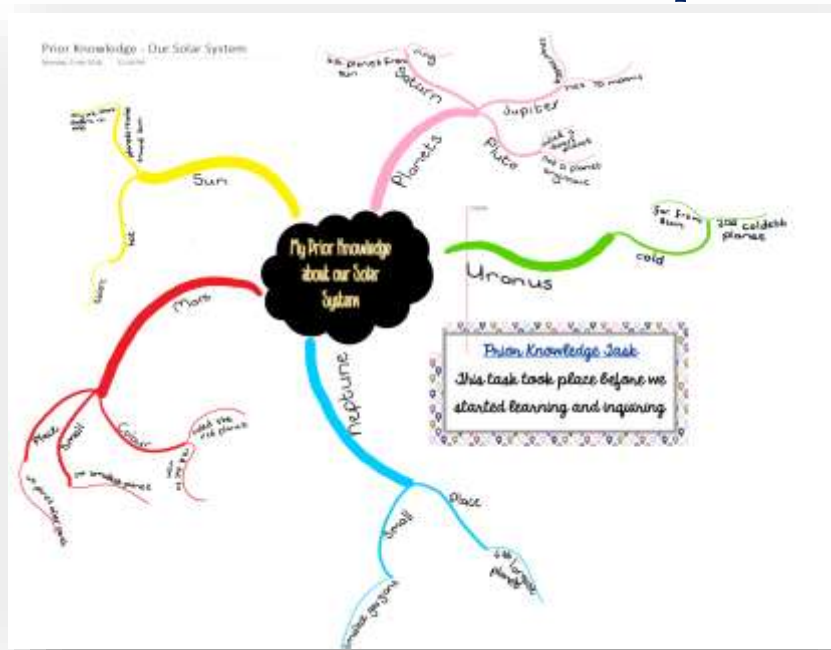

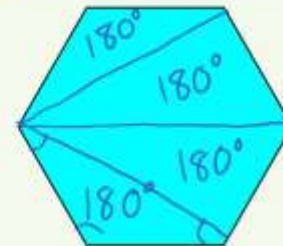

Educational Device

Your child's laptop is primarily an educational device. Some activities will interfere with a child's learning, so we ask that students refrain from using their laptops for the following activities whilst at the College:

- Installing games
- Playing games
- Listening to music
- Watching videos for entertainment





Specifications

CPU (Processor)	Intel i5 or i7 recommended, AMD equivalent acceptable
Hard Drive	128 GB SSD minimum
Memory (RAM)	8 GB minimum
Screen	Touch Screen with battery-powered pen 11 inch minimum Detachable or 360 rotation for a flat surface
Operating System	Windows 10 on a Windows 10 device (not Apple, Android or Chromebook)
Battery Life	6 hours of continuous use minimum
Front and Rear Camera	Devices must have front and rear cameras.
USB Ports	1 minimum



Essentials

- Laptop case for protection from impact
- Laptop bag for transporting laptop
- Mouse for ease of operation (Bluetooth mouse recommended)
- Headphones or earbuds for online learning sessions involving video tutorials
- Digital Pen (has a battery and fine point)
 - Spare battery will be needed over 3 years
 - Test the pen in store



Anti-virus/malware

- Don't install anti-virus like Norton, Symantec, AVG, Kaspersky, etc
- We use the default Windows 10 virus protection suite, updated as part of the Windows license
- Malware Bytes compliments antivirus and can clean an infected machine



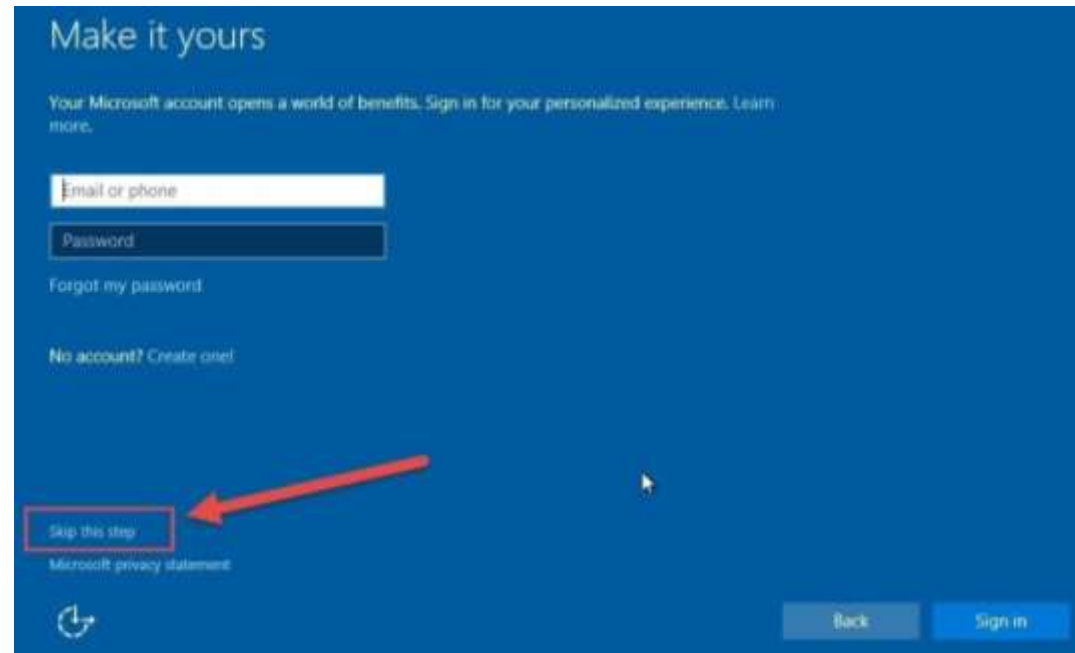
Warranty and Insurance

- Warranty - extend to three years
 - Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) Insurance
 - Dropped computers are not covered by warranty
 - Ask lots of questions
 - What is covered? Excess? Repair process?
- All devices purchased in the College portal have 3 years warranty and ADP.
- Some have a small excess of \$100 for ADP claims, some don't, you need to check each device.



Initial setup

- Do not assign an email address with your child's account
- Skip during the setup process
- **Students will have their computers set up in the first week**
- Don't purchase or install Office 365
- Primary – in class
- Secondary – new student orientation day





Helpful Hints

- Name pens
- Spare nibs for pens
- Pen batteries – ask at purchase point
- Make sure screen detaches or rotates 360⁰
- ‘You get what you pay for’
- Budget for 3 years of life – battery, wear and tear
- ADP is essential
- Monitor software installation – games, etc

- Some devices have been a 10-12 week delay in delivery.
- If you want one for Christmas please check in store.
- This mean you will need to purchase before the beginning of December if purchasing through the school portal.
