



## APPLICATIONS FOR THE SOUTH PASSAGE PROGRAM IN 2020

The Goda Foundation is prepared to sponsor students to participate in the following program in 2020:

- South Passage Voyage (Age restriction: 14+ years at time of leaving for the voyage)

Students who are interested in applying for this program must provide an expression of interest via email to Ms Brickell's office, Principal's P.A. Preference will be given to students who have fulfilled their commitments with APS Sport, House carnivals (swimming, athletics, cross country and extra-curricular activities). Students who apply must also have met the College's expectations with uniform and behaviour.

### South Passage 2020

The Goda Foundation will support students to participate in a South Passage voyage in 2020. The 2020 South Passage voyage will run during the September school holidays for five days from Monday 28 September to Friday 2 October.

The South Passage vessel leaves from Great Sandy Straits Marina, Urangan Harbour, Hervey Bay and returns to the William Gunn Jetty, Manly in Brisbane. Coach transport will be provided by the College on Sunday 27 September (leaving from the Saint Stephen's College car park next to Coles around 2.30pm). Students will stay onboard the vessel on Sunday evening before it leaves Urangan Harbour on Monday morning. Students will need to bring money for their dinner, which will be purchased along the way. Parents will be required to pick up their son/daughter from the William Gunn Jetty in Manly on Friday 2 October around 4pm.

Highlights include circumnavigating Hervey Bay and the Fraser Coast, whale watching, snorkelling the Tangalooma Wrecks and visiting the Giant Sandhills on Southern Moreton and Horseshoe Bay on Peel Island. The voyage cost is \$900 per person. The Goda Foundation has kindly offered to sponsor each student's voyage cost by \$500, which means students (parents) pay \$400 for the program plus a cost per head for the coach to Hervey Bay and breakfast on the first morning – to be determined.
