



APPLICATIONS FOR THE SOUTH PASSAGE PROGRAM IN 2024

The Goda Foundation is prepared to sponsor students to participate in the following program in 2024:

- South Passage Voyage (Age restriction: 14+ years at time of leaving for the voyage)

Students who are interested in applying for this program must provide an expression of interest via email to the Principal's office via principalsoffice@ssc.qld.edu.au

Students should research South Passage on www.southpassage.org.au and use this information in their application to address the reasons they believe they should be considered for the voyage. These should include the skills and attributes they would bring to the team, how they believe this tour would help them to develop on a personal level and how they would use their newly developed skills to contribute to the Saint Stephen's College and wider communities in the future.

South Passage 2024

The Goda Foundation will support students to participate in a South Passage voyage in 2024. The voyage will run during the Easter school holidays from Monday 8 to Friday 12 April.

The voyage will depart from and return to William Gunn Jetty in Manly, Brisbane, and will navigate both the sheltered southern waters and the more open waters to the north of Moreton Bay. Weather permitting, there should also be the opportunity for some night sailing and a venture outside Cape Moreton for some open ocean sailing, potentially even a circumnavigation of Moreton and North Stradbroke Islands.

Parents will be required to transport their son/daughter to and from the William Gunn Jetty in Manly. The drop-off time is by 8.30am on Monday 8 April at the latest, the pick-up is 4pm on Friday 12 April.

Highlights include snorkeling the Tangalooma Wrecks and visiting the Giant Sandhills on Southern Moreton and Horseshoe Bay on Peel Island. The voyage cost is \$1,150 per person and The Goda Foundation has kindly offered sponsorship of \$600 to each student.
