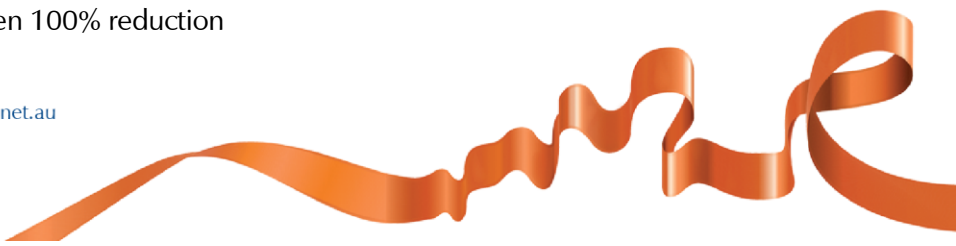

The payment of school fees and other costs are required to be paid in full by the designated date of each term (ie five days after the commencement of each term). Annual fees paid in advance (designated date at Term One) attract a reduction of 2.5% of tuition fees only. Please note: School Fee statements will be emailed to your preferred billing email address.

The College Board has approved a reduction in **tuition fees only** where two or more members of one family attend the College at the same time. Any other charges are payable as stated.

- First child fees as specified
- Second child 10% reduction
- Third child 20% reduction
- Fourth child 50% reduction
- Fifth and subsequent children 100% reduction

Capital Levy (compulsory)

The College Board has approved a reduction in the Capital Levy contribution where three or more members of the one family attend the College at the same time.

- First and second child as specified
- Third child 20% reduction
- Subsequent children 50% reduction

Booklists & Textbook Rental (incl. External On-line Resources)

The Booklist and Textbook levies are annual charges added to the Term 1 Fee Statement.

Years P-6 – The Levy funds the purchase of booklist stationery for in class use.

Year 7-12 – The Levy funds the textbook rental and subscription scheme. Textbooks that are not returned in a satisfactory condition will incur a fine or replacement cost.

Textbook Deposit

All Year 7 students and new students in Years 8 to 12 must pay a \$100 rental deposit before books will be issued. Rental deposits will be returned, at the time the student leaves the College, provided that all textbooks are returned in satisfactory condition.

Sports Levy

The Sports Levy supports the resourcing of sporting activities across the College. This includes the APS Sporting Competition.

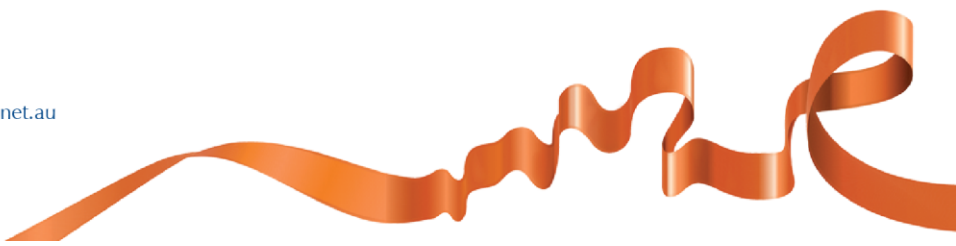
Other Costs

Students participate in excursions, incursions, camps, swimming, and other sporting events or similar etc, at various times throughout the year. The programs are a significant factor in promoting the personal and spiritual development of the students. While the costs of these activities are borne by parents, every effort is made to keep these costs at a minimum.

They will be added to your school fees account if accurate costs are known in advance, otherwise they are paid for as they occur. Information detailing the cost of any activity is forwarded prior to the event for your attention.

Specialist Tutors, Coaches & Facilitators

Separate charges are made by specialists for optional private tuition for a range of activities such as Instrumental (Brass, Woodwind, Percussion, Piano, Strings, Keyboard, Guitar), Speech and Drama, Vocal (Singing), Chess, Art, Taekwondo, Dance, EOL, Academic Advisor Program etc.





Please note the following school fees payment conditions applicable to the College.

School fees payment conditions

1. Payment of school fees and other costs is required to be paid in full by the designated date (five days after the commencement of each term, unless otherwise stated in writing).
2. The College will charge an administration fee of \$55 (including GST). This fee is payable if school fees, and other charges have not been finalized by the end of the term or no acceptable arrangements have been entered into by that time.
3. Overdue accounts, including those where agreements for the payment have not been honoured, will result in a review of the student's continuing enrolment at the College.
4. Unless the College has agreed otherwise, students school fee accounts must be finalised before students are allowed to proceed into the following years.
5. Default in payment of fees and other charges render the parents liable to legal action for recovery of the unpaid fees or other charges.
6. A full school term's notice, in writing, to the Principal is required of intention to withdraw a student from the school, otherwise a term's tuition fee for insufficient notice of withdrawal will be charged.
7. In the event that a student is asked to leave the College, all incurred fees and charges will be non- refundable and any outstanding fees and charges will be immediately payable.
8. Parents who are experiencing difficulties maintaining payment of fees and charges should contact the Principal through the College's Business Manager.

The College makes limited fee relief available to those families experiencing financial hardship in our College community. To help you, we will ask you to provide financial documents to support your application. Everything you tell us will be confidential and assessed on a case-by-case basis.
